EVACUATION ORDER

IR#3 Kahntah Reserve

Date: July 9, 2024

An **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Fort Nelson First Nation at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Due to the risk of wildfire the Fort Nelson First Nation is ordering visitors within the IR#3, Kahntah Reserve area you must evacuate. The area is described as IR#3 Kantah Reserve.

- 112 Km Southeast of IR#2 FNFN
- 109 Km Northeast of Prophet River
- 48 Km Northeast of Fontas Reserve
- 116 KM Southeast of Fort Nelson

All persons within the defined area are to evacuate via **Boat**. Please follow all road directions from authorities.

Based on this information, an order ***pursuant to the Authority of the Council under Sections 81 and 88 of the Indian Act*** to evacuate these areas has been authorized in the interest of life and safety.

Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and other agencies will be expediting evacuation of these areas on behalf of the Fort Nelson First Nation if required.

The Emergency Operations Centre is open and is providing support to the other emergency responders. The EOC phone line is in operation for information related to the Evacuation Order. Phone: 250-775-0716
