



EVACUATION ALERT

July 19, 2024, 1200 hrs

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Village of Cache Creek due to approaching wildfire.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Village of Cache Creek has issued an Evacuation Alert for the below listed addresses:

This Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

The following properties are now on Evacuation Alert:

1058, 1334, and 1298 Coyote Valley Road

All properties at the Cache Creek Regional Airport

945 Campbell Hill Drive West

205 Patterson Road

1100, 1101, 1170 and 1180 Campbell Hill Drive East

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents, pets and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure. Close all windows and doors.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbors, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call 250-457-3081.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.

Further information will be issued as needed when the situation changes.
