



Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Kluskus Lake Area

EVACUATION ALERT

Saturday, September 7, 2024 at 11:00 am

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation. Because of the potential danger to life and health caused by wildfire the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation has issued an Evacuation Alert for the following areas:

Kluskus IR 1 Kloyadingli IR 2 Sundaymans Meadow IR 3 Kluskus IR 14

Yaladelassla Indian Reserve IR 4

Recommended: Those who have appointments in town, low supplies, or if you sensitive to smoke head to town. Connect with staff to organize this. We can connect with ESS to get supplies delivered out if anyone needs. The fire could possibly cut off access to the 4000 rd within the next few days, which will cause a detour towards our old route 3900 rd at 66km.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Keep essential items such as eg. water, food, medication, important documents, clothing, personal items, eyeglasses, government-issued ID, valuable documents, immediate care needs for dependents or pets and, if you choose, keepsakes, readily available for a quick departure.
- Make arrangements for pets and livestock
- Secure your home (close windows, doors, and vents, remove flammable materials from around the property, lose gates and latch but do not lock)
- Make extra considerations for children and elders, have a plan to transport all family members should the area be brought under evacuation order. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children, and/or neighbors if assistance is needed.
- Monitor reliable news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of Reception Centers and the CRD's channels on Facebook and cariboord.ca/emergency.
